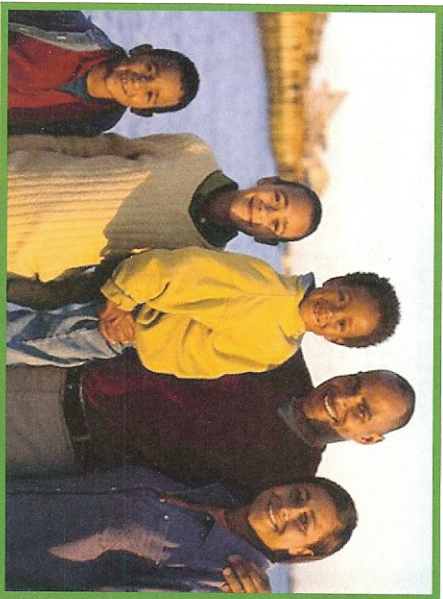
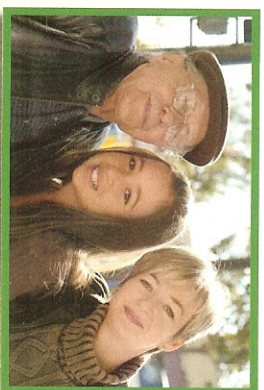


## The Loved Ones' Group

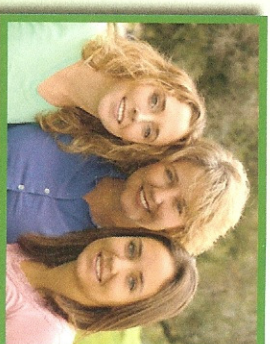

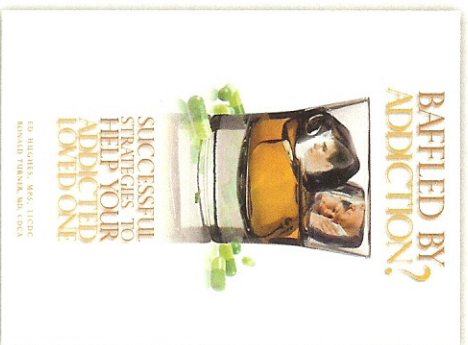
