Eligibility Information

- Not attending any school (as defined under State law)
- Between ages 16-24

One of more of the following (check all that apply)

- School Dropout
- A youth within the age of compulsory school attendance, but has not attended school for at least the most recent complete school calendar year.
- A low income recipient of a HSD/GED/TASC and is either BSD or an English language learner
- An individual who is subject to the juvenile or adult justice system
- A homeless individual, a runaway, an individual who is in foster care or has aged out, a child eligible for assistance under Section 477 of the SSA, or an individual who is in an out-of-home placement
- An individual who is pregnant or parenting
- An individual with a disability
- A low income individual who requires additional assistance to enter or complete an educational program or to secure or hold employment (see income chart below)

Documentation Needed During Enrollment

- Photo ID
- Social Security Card
- Birth Certificate
- Proof of Residence (mail with physical address)
- Proof of Income (2-3 pay stubs from parents or job and/or letter from DHHR stating income or help with income)
- Food Stamps (if applicable)
- Medical Card (if applicable)
- Income Tax Forms for past year
- Proof of # in family (birth certificates, medical card with members, or social security cards for all members)
