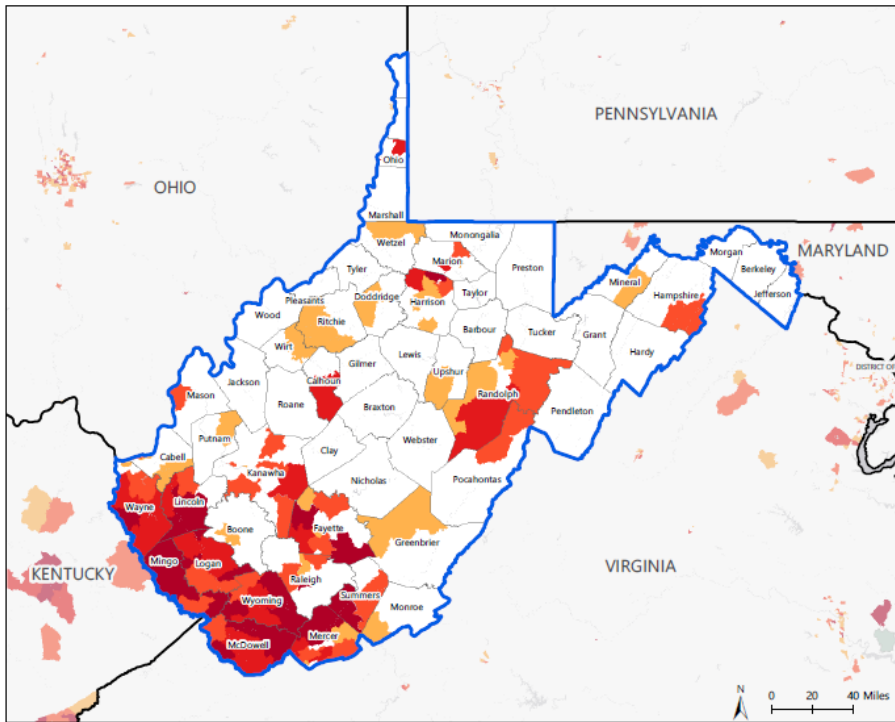


CENSUS 2020
