Without the funding from the Cabell Huntington Health Department Levy, we will be forced to begin charging citizens and businesses fees for services such as flu immunizations, health inspections, restaurant permits, and more.

Following is a small sampling of some of the inspection numbers in 2019:

Local Restaurants

The CHHD provides local restaurants with required **inspections at no charge**. Without our current funding, the following examples are just a few of the fees CHHD would have to charge:



Yearly Permit Fee (seating for 0-20)	\$250
Yearly Permit Fee (seating for 21-50)	\$300
Yearly Permit Fee (seating for 51-79)	\$400
Yearly Permit Fee (seating for 80+)	\$500
Mobile Food Unit	\$250
Facility Inspection	\$100
Inspection on valid complaint	\$100
